Since 1982, Dogwatch has been rescuing and rehoming dogs across Canterbury and beyond, giving thousands of dogs a second chance at life. Our vision is simple: every dog in a loving home. This propels us forward, to continue offering hope for dogs in need, until every dog has a safe and loving place to call their own.

We operate from a purpose-built adoption centre in Bromley, Christchurch, situated on 5 acres of land. Our facility includes two kennel blocks, large outdoor yards, two exercise paddocks, and a welcoming reception area. Additionally, we have a dedicated network of fosterers who provide loving temporary homes for dogs while they await adoption.

Rescue

We rescue dogs who have been abandoned, neglected, or surrendered, providing them with a safe place to stay while we assess their needs and plan for their future. We take in dogs from Canterbury Council pounds and private surrenders.

We ensure that every dog in our care is given the best chance to thrive. This includes behavioural rehabilitation, helping dogs rebuild their trust and confidence. We also provide medical rehabilitation, which involves a full health check, vaccinations, desexing, and any other treatments required to get each dog healthy and ready for their new home.

Rehome

Once rehabilitated, we work hard to find the perfect match for each dog, ensuring they are placed in loving homes where they can flourish. We take great care to match the needs of the dog with the lifestyle of their new family.

Community Outreach

Our work doesn't stop with the dogs in our care. We support dog owners in the community by offering desexing vouchers, advice on training and rehoming, and by providing food and essential supplies to help keep dogs with their families in times of hardship.
